4. No pupil shall be compelled to attend a class in which a religion instruction is given or take part in any religious exercises.
5. The private institutions shall employ only the trained/eligible on the same pattern in which appointments are made in the Govt. instructions in accordance with the recruitment and promotion rules of each category and norms laid down by N.C.T.E./N.C.E.R.T.
6. The school shall comply with the rules of the Department and directions as give by the Department so far as they are applicable to private schools in the interest of maintaining Education Standard. The Director of Education Shall Have the authority to send any of his officer for inspection for proper maintenance of educational standard holiday as per State Govt. etc.
7. The school shall have to furnish all informations and returns as called for by the Department from time to time.
8. No private institution shall function within the premises of exist in Govt. institution.
9. The school staff and students shall not take part in any Education directed against the authority of Govt. or disseminate opinions tending to excite feelings of disloyalty or disaffection against the Govt. or of amenity and haltered between different communities.
10. The school charge the rate of tuition fee and subscription to boys funds in accordance with the scales prescribed or approved by the Education Department of H.P/C.B.S.C/I.C.S.C. shall have to submit a class wise list of tuition fee and funds to this office.
11. No particular religious education shall be imparted by the institution to maintain secular character of the institution.
12. Permission to run or establish a private education institution shall be granted only on individual basis and no permitted institution shall be entitled to open its branches elsewhere.
13. Teaching and non teaching staff shall be paid salary commensurate to the fees and funds to be charged from the students, donations and other courses of income of institution.
14. Each teacher of private education institution shall be given work load in such a manner that it does not exceed 24 hours in a week in any case. In case of any non teaching staff, it shall be 7 hours (42 hours in a week)

- 15 All the posts to be filled to national daily news papers or getting sponsorship of name from the nearest employment exchange giving full detail of qualifications required and scales of pay plus allowances to be given.
- 16 Proper record of the receipt books to be used for charging fees and funds and other income etc. shall be maintained.
- 17 All the members of the staff shall be paid their salaries and related arrears through account payees bank cheques.
- 18 Each private institution shall from parents teachers association, the parents and teachers being its members. It shall have its executive body with two / three members from amongst parents and one/three members from amongst teachers. It shall be of advisory nature and still strive for the better running of the institution and maintain cordial relation between management parents and teacher.
- 19 The school shall maintain the discipline properly.
- 20 The school shall take steps to promote the use in Hindi. The extra reservation for SC/ST students at the time of admission be adhered to.
- 21 The school shall have to work within the frame work of national priorities.
- 22 Free education will be imparted to the girl students.
- The breach of any of the conditions specified above shall render the school defaulter and the Director of Education after conducting any enquiry through any of the officers so designed by him, shall have the power to cancel the N.O.C.
